BOARD POLICY DEVELOPMENT

Every school board in the state of Wyoming is required to formulate and enforce policies, rules, and regulations for the efficient and orderly operation of the schools under their control. Adopted policies serve as a guide for the administration and help to promote common understanding and uniformity in the basic procedures and operations of the schools of the district. It also is imperative for a board to have definite statements of policy in order to resolve the increasing and conflicting demands thrust it.

Policies are not infallible and must be reevaluated and appraised periodically in order that they may serve all in the best possible manner. Thus, policy development is an ongoing process.

The Board sincerely believes that by establishing a clear-cut course of communication between the Board, school officials, employees, and the community, it can provide stimulating and effective education and educational environment. The Board therefore shall involve staff members and citizens of the district in its policy development process.
