## **RELEASED TIME FOR RELIGIOUS INSTRUCTION**

The Board will cooperate with religious institutions in the district by permitting students to attend off-campus religious classes.

The following regulations shall govern the released time program:

- 1. The school will grant released time to students in grades 9 through 12.
- 2. The school will decide during what periods released time will be allowed.
- 3. The school may set up a system of registration for attending religious classes, but no advertising or recruiting shall be done by the school.
- 4. No credit will be given by the school for classes attended nor will any grades appear on report cards.
- 5. The religious institutions will be responsible for providing facilities, equipment, staff, and the total cost of their program.
- 6. The school will provide class lists of students to released time instructors.
- 7. Religious institutions wishing to have students participate in the released time program must contact the building principal for arrangements.
- 8. All religious classes must be held off school premises.
