SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AREAS

Under the general authority granted to school districts to assign children to schools as deemed in the best educational interests of all, the Board authorizes the superintendent, or designee, to grant or deny requests for individuals to attend a school outside of his/her designated attendance area after the patron has completed the "Change of Placement" form and consideration of the following criteria:

- 1. The change appears to be in the best interests of the individual.
- 2. No bus route will be extended beyond its normal run.
- 3. Principals of both schools involved approve of the change.
- 4. The superintendent, or designee, finds the change to be in the best interest of the district.
- 5. Unless there is a regular bus already in operation that has available seating, the parents will be responsible for transporting the child to and from school each day.
- 6. Certified staff and full-time employees' children will be considered in-area students in the school that the employee works in if that employee requests that placement.
