## UNPAID MEAL BALANCE

Students K – 12, who are on a full pay or reduced pay meal plan, can carry no more than \$15.00 in unpaid charges for meal plans. This will include a total of breakfast meals and/or lunch meals. It is the responsibility of the parents/guardians to maintain a positive balance for student meal accounts.

District employees can carry no more than \$10.00 in unpaid charges for meal plans.

The administration shall establish, and the Board shall approve, regulations and procedures which conform with state and federal (or other) requirements regarding participation in the NSBP and NSLP, price meals, and supplementary food.

Current practices as established by the Wyoming Department of Education, National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs Handbook, Chapter 4, and the Eligibility Manual for School Meals, Child Nutrition Programs Food and Nutrition Service, U.S. Department of Agriculture.
