

BOARD POLICY DEVELOPMENT

Every school board in the state of Wyoming is required to formulate and enforce policies, rules, and regulations for the efficient, safe, and orderly operation of the district. Adopted policies promote common understanding and uniformity in the basic procedures and operations of the district. It is imperative for a board to have definite statements of policy in order to resolve the ever changing.

Policies must be reevaluated and appraised periodically. Thus, policy development is an ongoing process. The Board shall involve staff members and stakeholders of the district in its policy development process.
